Sasabe Rd | Vaccines for surgery patients only (not a vaccine clinic): \$20 DAPP/PRC, \$18 rabies and e-collar required for males 5 months and older or at vet's discretion \$15 | Pima County residents, 3 Points area preferred, not Marana, Sahuarita or rescues | Sign in and remain in your car until your number is called.

- Asavet Low-Cost Spay/Neuter | May 10th | 8:00 AM check-in | The Animal League of Green Valley | 1600 W Dural Mine Rd, Green Valley, AZ | \$40 COPAY | Free Vaccines for surgery patients only (not a vaccine clinic) | Litters under 5 months – \$10/per animal (if Mom is spayed at the same time) | Annual limit 3 pets per household.

For all Asavet Spay/Neuter Events:

- No food after 12 am (the morning of surgery)
- Pets under 5 months of age do not need to have fasted
- All dogs must be on a lease or in the pet carrier
- All cats must be in a pet carrier
- All pets must be a minimum of 2 months old and weigh 2 pounds
- No appointments, only first come, first served
