- Pets under 5 months of age do not need to have fasted.
- All dogs must be on a lease or in the pet carrier.
- All cats must be in a pet carrier.
- All pets must be a minimum of 2 months old and weigh 2 pounds.
- No appointments, only first come, first serve.
